- To prevent loss, use sew-on or iron-on labels or a permanent waterproof marker to label all clothing, bedding, and equipment with your Kennebecer's name.
- Please pack in soft sided duffle bags only
- Include a packing list in your Kennebecer's duffle bag, so we can help keep track of clothing.
- We do laundry once per week for campers who stay longer than one week.
- Despite our best efforts, campers often lose or damage clothing and other items at camp. Please do not send money, valuables, expensive or delicate clothing, or mobile phones to camp. Campers simply do not need them while they're here. It is camp policy to collect mobile phones and store them in the office, until the end of the session.
- Camp does not replace lost or damaged items.
